Greetings from Hungary! We have been here in the country since June 8 and are getting settled in. Everything about moving to a new country is a learning process for sure. One example in particular is learning how to plan when shopping as items are often spread throughout multiple stores. What I mean by this is that food is at one store, all pharmacy type items are at another store, and if you want household items, then they are across town at another store. Having a shopping plan is essential as much of it is done on foot. The great news is that on the way, we see and meet many people and have great opportunities to work on learning the language. There is a lady at a local bakery that knows English (learned it through a Facebook group) that gets so excited as I try Hungarian and she practices her English. It is very fun to experience this. It is through relations like this that we will be able to share the gospel with the Hungarians as we are learning the language.



We spent some time in Budapest and was able to visit Saint Stephen's Basilica where the right hand of Saint Steven is kept. It was King Steven that declared Hungary a Christian (Catholic) nation.

We have applied for our visa's. There was a document that was needed that I had but the lady working on our case rejected it and asked for another one to be sent by the post office. I just said OK, and mailed it in. We should be accepted within the next few weeks for a visa. One thing that I learned was that our visa's can not be longer than our passports expiration dates, including the kids. Theirs expires January 2018, so we will need to renew them before getting a longer visa. Overall, there was not a problem. Praise the Lord!

Our flights to Hungary, with 20 pieces of luggage proved to be a challenge. However with Gods grace, we made it!.



We were able to visit the Shoes Along the Danube River memorial in Budapest which is in honor of the Jews that were massed killed during WWII. Hungary still has a large Jewish population that needs to be reached for Christ. Please pray to this end.
