Dear friends, Thank you for your kindness in prayers for the Mann family. I have read that there is an 80% chance of leaving the field within the first year on the field. Your prayers are needed as we continue to transition into the Hungarian life of language and culture. Senja and I have begun language school and it is proving to be a big challenge. It is rumored that Hungarian is the language of heaven because it takes an eternity to learn. What encouragement! The Lord has been so good with providing many preaching opportunities here in Hungary and Romania. I am thankful for the new friends we have met here on the field. I have had the privilege to preach a three-day Family Conference with great attendance in each service.



Senja and I were able to get a glimpse into a town in Hungary, it's the 16th largest here, Békéscsaba. To my knowledge, there is no Independent Baptist Bible preaching church in this town of 65,000 thousand. Hungary is filled with small towns and villages with 2500 or fewer people. At this time there is not the manpower to reach these small communities but I can bring the gospel to their mailboxes in the form of a track or John and Romans. There is a HUGE need for help and workers here in Hungary.

I am working now with both Fellowship Tract League and Bearing Precious Seed to get the much-needed literature in the country. I have started using Facebook to reach out to those who speak English trying to get something going with the language that I do speak. So far I have made a few contacts. Please pray for this outreach.

Our children are continuing to adjust well to life here and are doing well with their schooling. Praise the Lord for this. There are a few things that we are saving for. One is a good van, we are borrowing a car now but this won't last forever we need to purchase our own. The other is to either find a good printing company to work with or start working towards creating a new printing ministry here in Hungary. To start a printing ministry is much needed but expensive and would need to be operated by another individual. Please give these things to the Lord as you pray for Hungary.
